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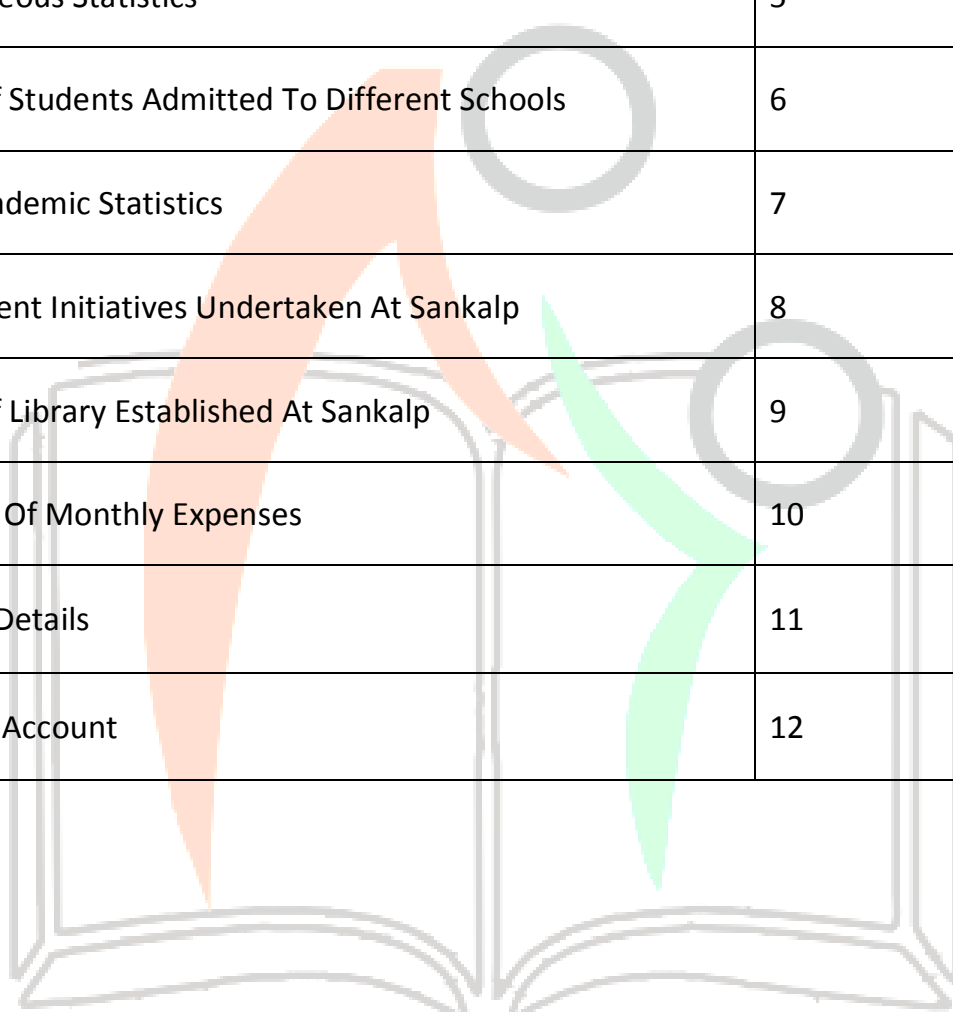

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WORKING OF SANKALP AND PRESENT SETUP

The current setup of SANKALP has provisions for conducting classes for Nursery to Std 9. Teachers and volunteers from NIT Jamshedpur are actively engaged in imparting education to kids in the slum areas. Apart from these computer classes, library, special activity classes, audio/video classes and fun-learning classes are also adequately taken care of. The general pattern followed at Sankalp is as shown below:

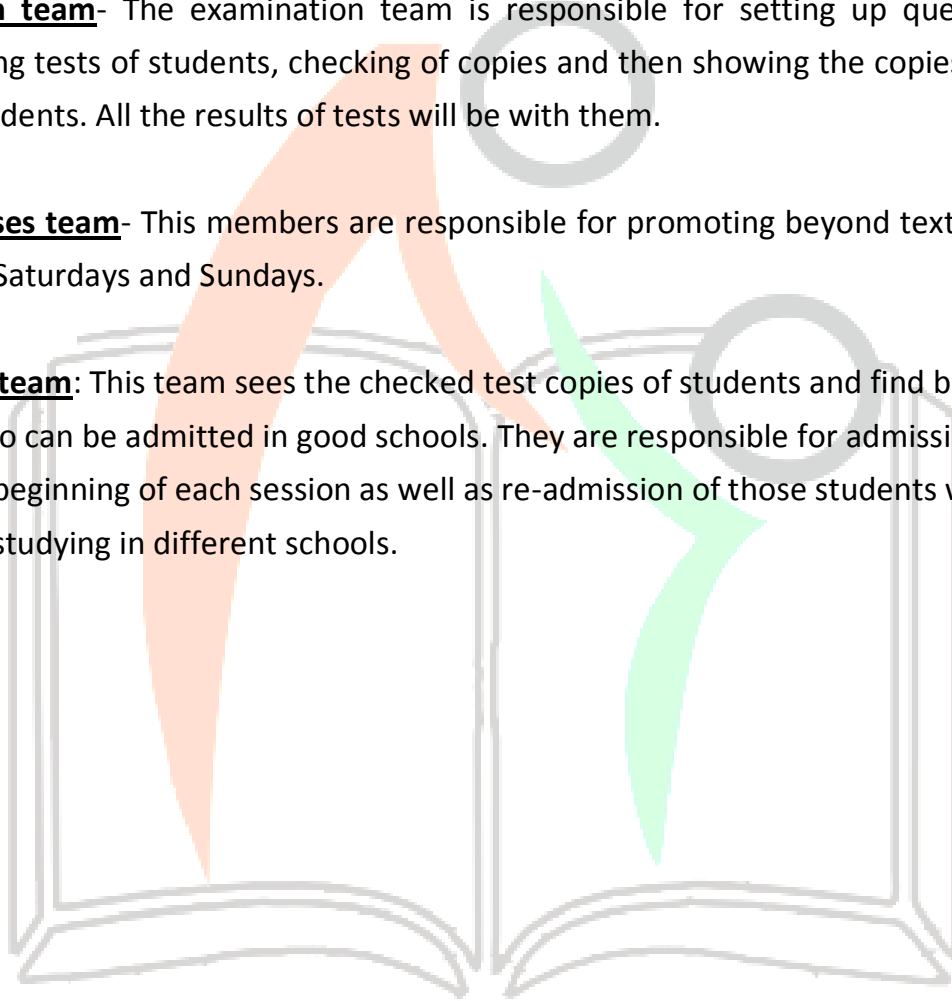

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE ACADEMIC TEAM

The academic team is the largest team of SANKALP and comprises of maximum number of members. The breakup of the whole team is as shown below:

- 1) **Mentors team**- The mentors are responsible for over-viewing the day to day activities at all Sankalp centres. This includes checking of attendance registers, attendance of volunteers, and strength of students in class.
- 2) **Examination team**- The examination team is responsible for setting up question papers, taking tests of students, checking of copies and then showing the copies and marks to students. All the results of tests will be with them.
- 3) **Special classes team**- This members are responsible for promoting beyond textbook learning on Saturdays and Sundays.
- 4) **Admissions team**: This team sees the checked test copies of students and find bright students who can be admitted in good schools. They are responsible for admission of students at beginning of each session as well as re-admission of those students who are already studying in different schools.

OTHER ACADEMIC STATISTICS

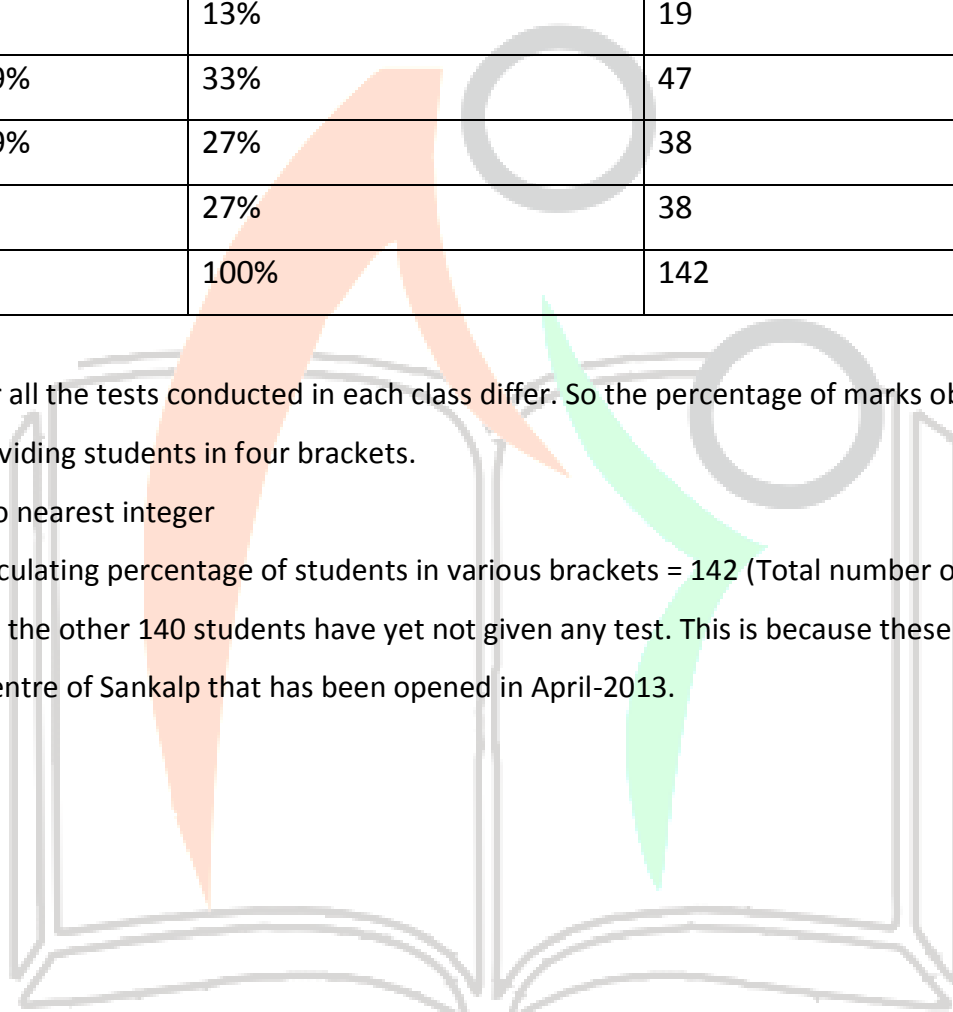
At Sankalp, periodic tests are a regular feature. This ensures that all the children are tested for what they are learning. The table below lists the breakup for percentage of students scoring marks in different brackets.

** Base value for calculating percentage of students in various brackets = 142 (Total number of registered students in Sankalp), the other 140 students have yet not given any test. This is because these students belong to the new centre of Sankalp that has been opened in April-2013.
