1. Presentation given to alumni of NIT, Jamshedpur about Sankalp during Alumni Meet in January 2014.
2. Opening of Sankalp centre near Aashiyana , Saldih Basti, Adityapur and Madhepura, Bihar
3. Financial aid to support the education of 24 kids studying in various schools of Jamshedpur and Patna.
4. Free of cost education facilities for 610 kids studying at Sankalp centres.
5. A total of 15 teachers hired on permanent basis to help volunteers in teaching the kids.
6. Starting of special classes for kids that focus on beyond textbook learning by means of puzzle activity, GK, inspirational videos, and group activity.
7. Celebration of Deepawali, Republic Day, Independence Day and Children's Day at Sankalp centres. Events witnessed display of documentaries, cartoons, gifts and presence of respected alumni members, volunteers, kids, and others students of college.
8. Updated and completely re-designed Sankalp website launched
9. Documentary 'Treasure of the Sea' made on a Sankalp student Amar Pratap by Andrew Hilton has been awarded in a seminar in Italy. The documentary, produced by Pilgrim Films, received its first award in 2011, being judged the best film in the Satyajit Ray Foundation Short Film Competition at the London India Film Festival. The film also bagged the People's Choice Award at Jeevika: Asia Livelihood Documentary Festival 2011.
10. Module of Training programme for all the new volunteers of Sankalp on teaching methods and practices made and adopted at Sankalp.
11. Critical decisions like display of documentaries from field work for motivation and membership drive, Personalized counselling for Sankalp children by volunteers led by President, using Sankalp Volunteers FB Page as a single point of information and updates and monthly circulation of Financial Report taken
12. Regular talks and interaction sessions started with students of different years for motivation and feedback.
13. Process of Monthly Meetings of President with volunteers, sharing minutes online, monthly visit of centres for counselling started
14. Special classes like audio visual and dance classes held for children at Aashiyana Centre
15. Summer and Winter Internship opened to students across the country. Three Students Vishal Singh (Engg.), Avinash (MBA, XIME, Kochi) and Sunita (Law College, Ranchi) got associated with Sankalp for brief periods and gave their recommendations
16. Medical Camp organized at Madhepura Centre, Bihar in which around 200 people, including 120 children took part in the camp
17. Sankalp got extensive News Coverage from Local and National Dailies like Telegraph and Hindustan Times
18. Student of Sankalp, Aditi, admitted to B.Tech course in Haldia Institute of Technology (Computer Science) with major contribution of her fees sponsored by Sankalp and its volunteers
19. PRAYAS - AN EFFORT TO TRY AND MAKE A DIFFERENCE' was a social initiative by Ojass and Sankalp Team to further the cause of women and child empowerment through

videos highlighting major issues confronting them
