### PRIDE OF SANKALP

1	Sankalp opened its FIRST SCHOOL for kids from Class 1 to Class 5 at Kalahandi
	District, Mohangiri Block, Odisha. The entire infrastructural cost was borne by
	Empower Kids Foundation and our alumnus Mr Vivek was instrumental in mobilizing
	the funds. The school would be run by professional teachers and Mr. Lalit & Mr. Sarojit
	would look after the management.
2	Academic session for the new batch was commenced at Sankalp Vidyalaya.42 students have
	taken admission and are currently taught by Mr Sarojit and Mr Lalit at the school. Sankalp
	arranged for the books and other required stationery for the students and will be sending
	money for purchasing uniform for the kids.
3	Proper Time Table and daily routine has been framed at Sankalp Vidyalaya for the new
	batch. The time-table would be posted on the walls for the help of the students.
4	Sankalp provided schools books for all the children at Sankalp Vidyalaya. Since the school
	has got NOC from Odiya Medium, all the books were in Odiya language.
5	Block Education officer of Mohangiri Block visited the school for inspection and DISE

9	Sankalp Vidyalaya will soon get the Certificate of Registration from Govt. of
	Odisha. Mr. Lalit has submitted all the necessary documents and has also built the
	necessary infra at the school which is required to get the certificate.
10	Somnath, our Giridih Centre Coordinator, tweeted to Mr. Hemant Soren, Chief
	Minister, Jharkhand about the lop sided and inefficient management of schools and
	prolonged delay in the infrastructure revamp of schools based in Giridih. CM took
	cognisance of the tweet and immediately ordered the district administration to
	consider the matter and report to CM Office.
11	First sports day in the history of Sankalp was organized at Adarsh Bhawan Centre.
	Centre coordinators spearheaded the entire event and it was a huge success. Interns
	from NMIMS who did their internship with Sankalp by taking classes for kids at
	Adarsh Bhawan Centre hosted the sports day and organized drawing competition
	which was also attended by President where winners were awarded. President and
	wife attended the sports day and enhanced the spirit and joy amongst the students.

## Centre Report

1	Cultural programs were organized at Sitalpur Centre, Giridih on completion of 1 year of centre operations. The centre was earlier run with the collaboration of Sankalp and Youth Cultural Society.
2	Sankalp inaugurated second centre dedicated for Navodaya preparation where eligible students from Mohan Nagar, NIT and Ikchapur centres have been enrolled.
3	Drawing Competition and speech competition were held at Sitalpur Centre. The winners were awarded by Somnath and centre teachers to encourage students to participate
4	Weekly centre report format was formalized for Giridih Based centres to get the updates. All the teachers are regularly sending the reports and gradual improvement in the academic level of the children is noticeable with improvement in test marks and extra- curricular activities.
5	Drawing Competition for junior batch and Speech competition for Senior batch was held at Sihodih Centre, Giridih.
6	Common Tests were conducted each month and master roll CT was updated regularly
7	To encourage students towards extra-curricular activities, speech and drawing competition & musical chair event was held at Sihodih Centre, Giridih.
8	As part of the National Yoga Day, yoga diwas was celebrated at our Telco Centre where in students were encouraged to perform simple yoga exercises.
9	Speech and Drawing Competition was held at Sitalpur Centre. The winners were awarded by the chief guests. The theme of the competition was "Save the water and hygiene". More than 80 students participated in the competition and brought their creative genius with their creations.
10	Drawing Competition was held at Dhanbad Centre and the winners were awarded on World Environment Day. Singing and Poster making competition was also held at the centre.
11	Rotary Club based in Telco organized a stationery distribution and book donation at Telco Centre. Around 1500 books were donated for the library at Telco Centre by the Rotary Club.
