

MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT-January 2016

1. Sankalp Team in association with Empowered Kids Foundation started a full fledged tuition centre at MIG Colony , Near Durga Mandap , Adityapur, The centre will focus on chiefly two aspects
 - a. Building academic fundamentals of children residing in the rickshaw basti and Bantanagar slum areas
 - b. Mentoring thru tuition classes for admission to Navodaya of few selected students
 - c. Classes will be run in 3 shifts at MIG Centre
 - i. 3.30 PM-4.30 PM-Saraswati Devi-Junior Section
 - ii. 4.30 PM-5.30 PM-Rajan Sir & Dilip Sir-Secondary Section
 - iii. 5.30 PM-7 PM-Navodaya Team-Entrance Preparation
 - d. A team of dedicated volunteers from NIT , who are themselves Navodaya Alumnus will be mentoring the selected children for admissions
2. A draft proposal for sponsoring the complete admission fee for the academic session 2016-2017 of selected students from Sankalp's Telco Centre was submitted to CSR Deptt. TML Drivelines
 - a. A total of 31 children were selected for sponsorship
 - b. Their admission, tuition ,travelling and all other incidental fee would be sponsored by TML thru Sankalp
3. Sankalp in association with Goonj- A nationwide renowned NGO for organizing donations for underprivileged children arranged a camp at Madhepura Centre. 2 pairs of shoes were distributed to each student at Sankalp's Madhepura Centre. Navneet Prabhakar,Treasurer, Sankalp coordinated to organize the event successfully
4. Sankalp achieved another breakthrough when it penetrated in to Maoist affected areas in Bihar and established centres in Jamui and Banka the two most backward districts of Bihar. The centre will be administratively managed by Pahal-Ek Nayi Soch, an NGO operating in Bihar for catering to the education of the needy children. Sankalp will pay the complete salary component of teachers and all infra related stuff like Dari, Chair and White Board
5. Sankalp plans to further colloborate with Pahal to expand it footprints in Bihar across 12 districts namely
 - a. Lakhisaray
 - b. Shekhapura
 - c. Nawada
 - d. Gaya
 - e. Bihar Sharif
 - f. Samastipur
 - g. Bhagalpur
 - h. Khagariya
 - i. Begusarai
6. Sanjeevani, Sankalp's first edition of comprehensive syllabus for all classes to benchmark educational levels at all our centres was released on 26th January. Copies of Sanjeevani have now been given to teachers at all centres. The syllabus has been formed by compiling the basic minimum syllabus of all boards and aspires to achieves for all students a basic minimum academic level]
7. Special classes for girls and their mothers enrolled at our centres were organized on 15th Jan. The class was conducted by Girls Volunteers of Sankalp and the impact was overwhelming with many girls shared their ignorance on basic hygiene and personal health. This was again a milestone for Sankalp as physical education is literally not covered in any syllabi of GOI. The topics touched were:
 - a. Negative and positive touch

- b. Understanding their body when they reach puberty
 - c. Periods (since most of the girls in poor families use cloth and pads are not affordable, they should be taught how to properly use cloth like regular washing drying etc)
- 8. Test was conducted at NIT centre to group the children according to their actual academic levels. Volunteers have formed groups to pay special attention to weak children
- 9. 11 children have been identified from Mohan Nagar area for their admission to private schools in the academic session 2016=2017. Admission team is toiling hard for preparing these children for their entrance exams. All formalities wrt school forms etc have been completed
- 10. Republic Day was celebrated with full fanfare at all Sankalp Centres. We were fortunate to have Mr. Amrit Singh, 1960 batch NIT Alumnus as our chief guest.
- 11. Dhanbad centre celebrated its first Republic Day and test was conducted to identify 2 bright students for admission to nearby private school
- 12. Rajneesh, our teacher at Aashiyana will also lead preparation for Navodaya from Feb'16 month. 10 qty oxford English and translation were procured and handed over to him.
- 13. Sankalp was the major attraction in the Annual alumni meet of NIT Jamshedpur. We received an overwhelming response both in terms of funds and connectivity and help.
 - a. 7 alumnus agreed to sponsor children
 - b. Fund collected to the tune of around 1.6 lacs
 - c. Contacts for CSR Deptt of various companies
- 14. Sankalp is now making efforts to start a centre in Sonagachhi, a red light area. The target children are the kids of women working in such areas where mainstreaming is the main challenge
- 15. Sankalp Team is also participating in the annual donation festival called Kolkata gives festival
- 16. Sankalp is now focussing on extending support to more of such needy children thru help received from our 92 batch Alumni- Kapil Modi. Efforts to e be made in the following areas by president
 - a. Setting up a centre in the slum area near Dindli Enclave
 - b. Approaching Tata Steel for becoming its CSR arm in areas around CRM Bara
 - c. Approach 92 batch alumnus for fund rising
- 17. Sankalp will now sponsor 1 child from Madhepura centre and hire an additional teacher for catering to the growing student strength at the centre
- 18. Mr. Satish Satyarthi, NIT alumnus from Gwalior, will be approached for admitting needy children in his school
- 19. President also submitted a draft proposal for extending sankalp centre across the country to the CSR Deptt of ONGC.
- 20. Sankalp organized a PR cum awareness session in Mohan Nagar Area.
- 21. Monthly interaction led by President took place with the Team and special mention was made to the tireless efforts which the volunteers are making for making the different activities successful
- 22. Both Sankalp-A pledge to change and Sankalp Volunteers group FB page noted huge hike in likes and membership over the month
- 23. Sankalp saw a huge rise in daily requests for addition to its FB Page of Sankalp Volunteers group
